Happy July 4th weekend to all!! It's going to be a great time here at the campground; what a perfect way to celebrate our independence with friends, family and fellow campers! We have planned many activities for all to enjoy; including a fishing contest, a children's craft and festive campground parade, the first ever Rockey's Olympic Triathlon and a "not your typical" hayride (water will be involved)! Thursday 7/4

2:00 pm: Official start to the holiday weekend, campsite check-in begins! Don't forget to pick up your weekend event flyer in the campground store.

Friday 7/5

10:00 am: Fishing contest begins. All ages are encouraged to participate. If you think that you have caught the winning fish whether it's a bluegill, perch, speck, bass, or even a "trash" fish (dogfish, bullhead etc.) from one of our lakes, be sure to bring it to the boat launch (look for the blue canopy) to be weighed and measured. You may just have the winning catch! Cash prizes will be awarded! Watch the board near the boat launch for updates on the biggest fish.

Entries will be accepted daily from 10:00am-8:00pm at the boat launch. All entries MUST be received by 8:00pm on Saturday

Ages 14 and under: A total of seven daily (Friday and Saturday) winners will be determined (one winner per category); with a cash prize of \$10 being delivered to your campsite after bingo concludes on Friday and Saturday night.

Ages 15 and over: If you have the winning fish, in each category, you will be awarded \$20; to be delivered to your campsite on Sunday morning.

10:30 am: Patriotic parade throughout the campground (15 years of age and younger). Meet Vickie at the community building to kick-off the holiday weekend in true patriotic style! Be sure to wear your red, white and blue apparel. Many instruments will be in hand to alert fellow campers of our parading through the park! Non-participants be ready at your campsites to cheer on the kids as they walk by.

3:30 pm: Rockey's Olympic Triathlon. Time to have some fun and race to the finish line! We will have two separate events, divided by age group (see below) for this Rockey's first. Medals to be awarded to the winners in each group.
